

#### 4 Reservations:

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

##### 4.1 Reservation for Backward Class category Candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State is as per the details in table given below. The percentages of reservation are the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates, which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority (Refer notes 1-5 given below for details). These are the minimum percentages of reservation exclusive of the backward class candidates securing allotment through General Merit by virtue of merit. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form for Centralized Admission.

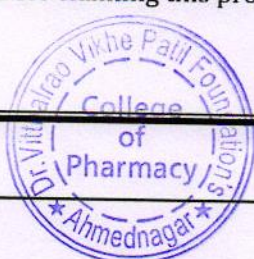
##### 4.2 Reservation for sons/daughters of Defence service personnel:

Five (5) % seats of the total sanctioned intake for an institute, subject to a maximum of five (5) seats in each institute coming under CAP shall be reserved for

- Children of ex- service personnel who are domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-1).
- Children of active service personnel who are domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-2).
- Children of active service personnel (DEF-3) –
  - Who are transferred to Maharashtra State but are not domiciled in Maharashtra State,
  - Who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State but their families are stationed in Maharashtra State under the provision of retention of family accommodation at the last duty station on grounds of children's education provided further that, such candidate should have appeared and passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination from a school/college situate in the State of Maharashtra.

These seats are within the sanctioned intake capacity and are available as **State Level seats**. A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 & DEF3 candidates shall be prepared. Admission against the Defence category seats will be made strictly on the basis of inter-merit combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 & DEF3 candidates. Refer Proforma C, D and E for claiming this provision.

This provision is NOT available to the children of **CIVILIAN STAFF** who is working / who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.

#### 4.3 Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidates:

As per the provisions in Clause 39 of Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act 1995, three percent (3%) seats of total sanctioned intake capacity of all the institutions coming under CAP shall be reserved for Persons with Disability candidates.

- 1% seats for Visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1)
- 1% seats for Speech & hearing impaired (deaf & dumb) candidates, (P2)
- 1% seats for Orthopedic disorders, learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphica, Spastic (P3)

Allotment of the seats reserved for the Persons with Disability candidates shall be done on the basis of an inter-se merit of respective type of handicap of such candidates. **These seats are available in HU / SL seats for Maharashtra Type - A, B and D only**

#### Note:-

It should be noted that the Persons with Disability candidates on admission to Engineering / Technology degree course will not be given any exemptions or additional facilities in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities. Further it is specifically brought to the notice of Persons with Disability candidates that, they should submit the certificates strictly as per the Proforma- F/F-1.

#### 4.4 Reservation for Female candidates:

As per the provisions in Govt. Resolution No. GEC-1000/ (123/2000)/ Tech. Edu.-1, dated 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2000, 30% seats available for Maharashtra State CAP shall be reserved for female candidates in all the courses of the institutions coming under CAP. This reservation shall be applicable for General, SC, ST, DT/VJ (NT-A), NT-B, NT-C, NT-D and OBC categories. Seats reserved for Female candidates are available under 70% Home University seats, 30% Other than Home University seats and State Level seats coming under the CAP. There shall be no reservation for Female candidates under Defence, Persons with Disability and SBC categories.

**IMPORTANT:** All such candidates who fail to substantiate claims made (such as reservation category, PH, Defence etc.) with necessary supporting documents shall be converted to GENERAL category and/or such applications will be rejected as the case may be. Once such candidates are converted to GENERAL category and they will have to fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria as set out for a GENERAL category candidate.

#### 4.5 Reservation of seats for the candidates belonging to the Maharashtra- Karnataka Border (disputed area) MS Type-E candidates:

These candidates will only be eligible for OHU/SL seats of Maharashtra State of CAP. These candidates will also be eligible for the seats remaining vacant in Un-aided Institutes after the CAP round and for additional round of Government, Government Aided, Autonomous Institutes, University Departments and University Managed Institutes.

#### General Note:

1. The reservation for backward class candidates shall be available in Government, Government Aided, Autonomous Institutes, University Dept. and University Managed Institutes and Unaided Non-Minority colleges and it will be 50% of Maharashtra State CAP seats. The provision of this reservation is not available in Unaided Minority Institutes
2. Candidates belonging to **Special Backward Class (SBC)** will be offered reservation up to 2% seats of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority subject to condition that any seats remain vacant in the reserved

category at the end of stage-II of allotment. These seats are carved out during the allotment stage-II and no separate seats are earmarked before the start of the allotment process. SBC Candidates having original category OBC will be considered at par with OBC Candidates.

3. The candidates belonging to **SC, ST, VJ/DT (NT(A)), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC** categories should produce "**Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate**" issued by Scrutiny Committee of Social Welfare Department/Tribal Department at **the time of submission** of CAP application form for the Admission. The policy of Social Justice & Welfare and Tribal Development Department shall be implemented in this regards.
4. Even if the candidate belonging to Backward Class Category secures admission against a seat belonging to the General category by virtue of merit, such candidate has to produce all the necessary documents in support of the category claimed both at the time of admission and while filling up of the CAP admission form.
5. In case of Reservation for Maratha Candidates any amendments/Acts/Judgments which may be published by Government/Hon. Courts of India from time to time will be applicable to Candidates and Institutes covered under these rules of admission.
6. All OMS candidates are treated as GENERAL/OPEN candidates and are not eligible to claim reservation for Backward Class category candidate.

## 5 Assignment of Merit Number:

### 5.1 Merit Number for Maharashtra Candidates:

1. Each eligible Maharashtra State Candidate (Rule 2.1) who has appeared for JEE (Main) 2015(Paper1) and obtained a **positive composite score** and submitted application form on or before the last date prescribed for the submission of Application Form for Admission to Engineering through CAP will be assigned a provisional merit number.
2. Merit of all eligible Maharashtra State candidates will be based on **positive composite score**; the **positive composite score** shall be calculated upto 8 decimal places. Relative merit in case of a tie (i.e. equal **positive composite score**) shall be resolved as per rule no. 5.1.1.

#### Note:

- a) Merit list of Maharashtra State Candidates so prepared shall indicate a State level General Merit No., State level Category Merit no. (as applicable), Home University General Merit No., Home University Category Merit no. (as applicable) etc.
- b) Assignment of a Merit number does not indicate or ensure admission to any seat.

### 5.1.1 Relative Merit in Case of a Tie:

In the case of candidates securing equal **positive composite score**, their relative merit will be fixed on the basis of the following order of preference:

- a. A candidate securing higher marks in JEE(Main)2015 Paper1
- b. A candidate securing higher marks in Mathematics. in JEE(Main)2015 Paper1
- c. A candidate securing higher marks in Physics in JEE(Main)2015 Paper1.
- d. A Candidate securing higher percentage of marks for his/her Board/qualifying examination for Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry.
- e. A candidate securing higher Percentage of marks in the subject Mathematics at HSC (Std. XII).
- f. A candidate securing higher Percentage of marks in the subjects Physics at HSC (Std. XII).
- g. A candidate securing higher Percentage of marks in Aggregate at HSC (Std. XII) Examination.
- h. Birth Date of the candidate. (Elder Candidate will be given preference)

3.	<b>Type C :</b> Does not satisfy as Type A and Type-B <b>But</b> <i>Father or Mother of the candidate</i> is an employee of the Government of India or Government of India Undertaking who is posted and reported to duty in Maharashtra State before the last date for submitting the application for Admission.
4.	<b>Type D:</b> Does not satisfy as Type A, Type-B and Type-C <b>But</b> <i>Father or Mother of the candidate</i> is an employee of the Government of Maharashtra / Government of Maharashtra Undertaking.

### 3.2 Type of Candidature for Outside Maharashtra State (OMS) candidates

Sr. No	Eligibility	Type of Candidature
1.	<b>Type OMS :</b> OMS candidate should be an Indian national, who is not satisfying any of the conditions Stated in Sr. No. 1, 2, 3, 4 ( <i>i.e.</i> , Type A,B,C,D) of rule 3.1.	OMS (Outside Maharashtra State)

In brief, candidate will have type of candidature as "Outside Maharashtra State" if the Indian National candidate passes **either HSC or Qualifying examination or both the examinations** from a college outside Maharashtra State **AND the candidate does not satisfy conditions of being either of the Type A, B, C or D candidature.** There shall be no reservation for the backward class category seats in case of OMS candidates.

#### 4 Reservation for Backward class Candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State are as per the details shown in Table 3. The percentages of reservation are the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates (Maharashtra State seats) who are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority in the Government/Government Aided/University Department / University Managed institutes/ Unaided Non-Minority Institutions. In Unaided Minority Institutes, there is no reservation for backward class category candidates; however reservation for backward class candidates can be implemented under CAP provided that the management of the institute gives the written consent.

Backward class candidates from the Maharashtra State only as per candidature type defined above (Rule 3.2) shall claim the category to which they belong at the time of submission of CAP application form for Admission. These are the minimum percentages of reservation exclusive of the backward class candidates securing allotment through General Merit.

Candidates belonging to **Special Backward Class (SBC)** will be offered reservation up to 2% of the seats, available for Maharashtra candidates (Maharashtra State seats), which are coming under the

purview of the Competent Authority subject to **condition that seat remain vacant in the reserved category at the end of stage-I of allotment process.** These seats are carved out during the allotment of stage-I and no separate seats are earmarked before the start of the allotment process. **SBC** Candidates having original category OBC will be considered at par with OBC Candidates.

- 4.1.1** The candidates from Maharashtra State claiming the reservation for backward classes should submit "**Caste certificate**" in the name of the **candidate** issued by the **Executive Magistrate/Metropolitan Magistrate in Maharashtra State clearly mentioning the Category of the candidate and also the remark that the caste is recognized as backward class category belonging to the State of Maharashtra** at **the time of submission** of CAP application form to ARC for the Admission.
- 4.1.2** The candidates belonging to SC, VJ/DT (NT(A)), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC categories MUST SUBMIT "**Caste Validity Certificate**" issued by Scrutiny Committee of Social Welfare Department and the Candidate belonging to ST category MUST SUBMIT "**Tribe Validity Certificate**" issued by Scrutiny Committee of Tribal Department at **the time of submission** of CAP application form to ARC for the Admission. The policy of Social Justice and Special Assistance Department and Tribal Development Department of state Government will be made applicable in case of Caste/ Tribe Validity Certificate.
- 4.1.3** The candidates belonging to VJ/DT (NT(A)), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC categories should produce "**Non Creamy layer Certificate**" issued by Sub Divisional Officer / Deputy Collector of the district in addition to the caste certificate at **the time of submission** of CAP application form to ARC for the Admission. The "**Non Creamy layer Certificate**" should be valid up to **31<sup>st</sup> March 2016.** If these candidates are not able to produce the Non Creamy layer certificate at the time of submission of CAP application form for the Admission, then such candidates will be treated as **GENERAL** category candidates and such candidates will not be able to claim reserved seats in the admission process.
- 4.1.4** Seats under reserved category are to be offered to the Backward Class candidates belonging to the Maharashtra state only and no OMS candidate belonging to Backward Class will be admitted against these seats. **If the Candidate is migrated from other state and got the migrated caste certificate then such candidates will not be considered for the benefit of the reservation, such candidate will be considered as General Candidate.**
- 4.15** In case of Reservation for Maratha Candidates any amendments/Acts/Judgments which may be published by Government/Hon. Courts of India from time to time will be applicable to Candidates and Institutes covered under these rules of admission.

## **4.2 Reservation for Persons with Disability:**

As per the provisions in **Clause 39 of Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act, 1995**, three percent (3%) seats of total sanctioned intake capacity **of all the institutes** shall be reserved for Persons with Disability candidates. **These seats shall be within the sanctioned intake of the institute and reserved only for Maharashtra State Candidates having type A and B as mentioned in Table 2 of Rule 3.1.**

Out of the three percent reservation for Persons with Disability candidates:

- **PH-1:** Visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1)
- **PH-2:** Speech and hearing impaired (dumb and deaf ) candidates, (P2)
- **PH-3:** Candidates with orthopedic disorders and learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphia, Spastic (P3).

**Certificate required:** The candidate shall produce a certificate, in the prescribed proforma "F", from the Director, All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai or Dean/Civil Surgeon of **the Government / CIVIL HOSPITALS** normally located at the District Headquarters, regarding his or her physical disability, and ability to undergo all parts of syllabus for the normal course. Candidates suffering from Dyslexia, Dysgraphica and Dyscalculia are required to produce certificate (proforma F-1) issued by the 'Learning Disability Clinic, Lokmanya Tilak Municipal General Hospital, Sion, Mumbai-22'.



**Note:**

1. The percentage of Handicap shall not be less than 40% and the nature of disability should be of permanent nature. (Proforma F and F-1).
2. Allotment of the seats reserved for the Persons with Disability candidates shall be done on the basis of merit list of such candidates.
3. It should be noted that the Persons with Disability candidates on admission to post graduate Engineering/ Technology course will not be given any exemption or additional facilities in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities.

**5.0 Selection basis and Selection Procedure adopted for Admission through CAP**

**5.1 Assignment of Merit Number**

**5.1.1 Merit Number**

There will be **TWO separate Merit Lists** for

- i. **General Merit List** – All the Sponsored / Non-Sponsored eligible candidates
- ii. **NRI Merit List** - Sons and daughters of NRI persons seeking admission in Government and Govt. Aided Engineering Colleges including Autonomous Institutes and University Departments (as per **Sr. No. 1 of Table 1**).

The **Sponsored/Non-sponsored** candidates **with Positive GATE Score (In absence of valid GATE Score, Merit shall be based on Marks obtained out of 100)** will be assigned a **General Merit Number, Category Merit Number etc.**

The sons and daughters of NRI persons seeking admission in Government and Govt. Aided Engineering Colleges including Autonomous Institutes and University Departments (as per **Sr. No. 1 of Table 1**) will be assigned an **NRI merit list** number.

Priority shall be given to Candidates with Valid GATE Score in the Merit generation

**5.1.2 Relative merit in case of equal marks:**

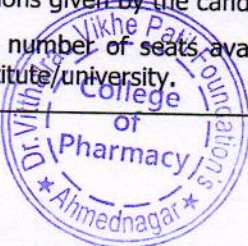
In the case of candidates securing equal GATE Score/Marks, their relative merit will be determined on the basis of the following order of preference:

- a. Higher percentage of marks scored in aggregate at the HSC (Std. XII)/ Diploma/ or its equivalent examination
- b. Higher percentage of the marks scored in the aggregate at the SSC (Std. X) or its equivalent examination.
- c. higher percentage of marks scored in the subject Mathematics at SSC (Std. X) or its equivalent examination.
- d. Birth date of candidate: Elder candidate will be given preference.

**NOTE:** In case of tie of Aggregate Marks of Bachelor degree or equivalent for **sons and daughters of NRI** persons, Rule 5.1.2 (a, b, c, d) shall be applicable.

**5.1.3** The seats will be allotted to the candidates strictly on the basis of

- a. *Inter se* merit of the candidate,
- b. options given by the candidate and
- c. the number of seats available for eligible candidates at the time of allotment in respective institute/university.



- (ii) Eligible Maharashtra State Candidates having their parent's annual income less than Rs.6.00 Lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible for these seats. The candidate shall submit Income certificate issued by Appropriate Authority.

**(III) Admissions Procedure**

These seats are allotted by the Competent Authority as per inter-se merit. For this purpose the Competent Authority shall invite applications, prepare a separate merit list for this category by following the same criteria as for Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates. In the event of non-availability of students in this category the same shall not be given to any other category of applicants.

**(d) Jammu and Kashmir Candidates and North East States:**

- (i) The admission to the candidates as per *Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) for the students belonging to Jammu and Kashmir Candidates and the scheme of Government of India of allocation of supernumerary seats in AICTE approved colleges to North Eastern States and UTs (NEUT) which lack in such facilities of technical education* shall be done by the competent authority appointed by the Central Government as per their eligibility criteria.
- (ii) The Fees shall be as that of for the Non Autonomous Government Institutes.

**7(6) Reservations:**

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to **candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only** subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

**(a) Reservation for Backward Class category Candidates:**

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State is as given below. The percentage of reservation is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates, coming under the CAP. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form for CAP.

- (i) These seats are within the sanctioned intake and are available as **State Level seats.**
- (ii) A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 and DEF3 candidates shall be prepared.
- (iii) Candidates claiming these seats shall produce additional documents in Proforma C, D and/or E as applicable.
- (iv) This provision is NOT available to the children of **CIVILIAN STAFF** who is working /who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.

**(c) Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidate:**

Three percent (3%) seats of total sanctioned intake of all the Institutions under CAP shall be reserved for Candidates with Disability.

- (i) 1% seats for Visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1),
- (ii) 1% seats for Speech & hearing impaired (deaf & dumb) candidates (P2),
- (iii) 1% seats for Orthopedic disorders, learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphica, Spastic (P3)


The allotment of seats reserved for the Candidates with Disability shall be done on the basis of an inter-se merit of respective type of handicap of such candidates. **These seats are available in HU / SL seats for Maharashtra domiciled candidates.**

The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the certificates strictly as per the Proforma- F/F-1.

**Note:-**

Candidates with Disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities.

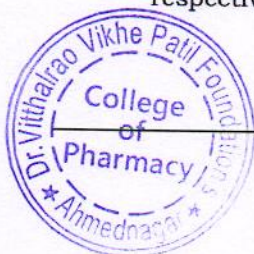

The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the certificates strictly as per the Proforma- F/F-1.

Candidates with Disability should note that on admission to postgraduate degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities.

Candidates with Disability should note that on admission to post graduate degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities.

**(c) Reservation for EWS Candidate:** As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. राआधो -4019/प्र.क्र.31/16-अ, dated 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2019, 10% seats shall be reserved for EWS candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CAP as per the policies of the Government declared from time to time. These seats shall be over & above the sanctioned intake.

**(d) Reservations for Orphan Candidates** - One percent (1%) seats of CAP Seats (excluding Minority institutions, All India Seats, if any) shall be reserved for Orphan Candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CAP as per Government Resolution, Women and Child Welfare Department, No. AMJ-2011/C.R. 212 / Desk 3 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2018 and the policies of the Government declared from time to time.
