

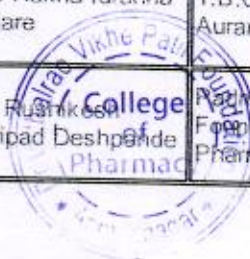

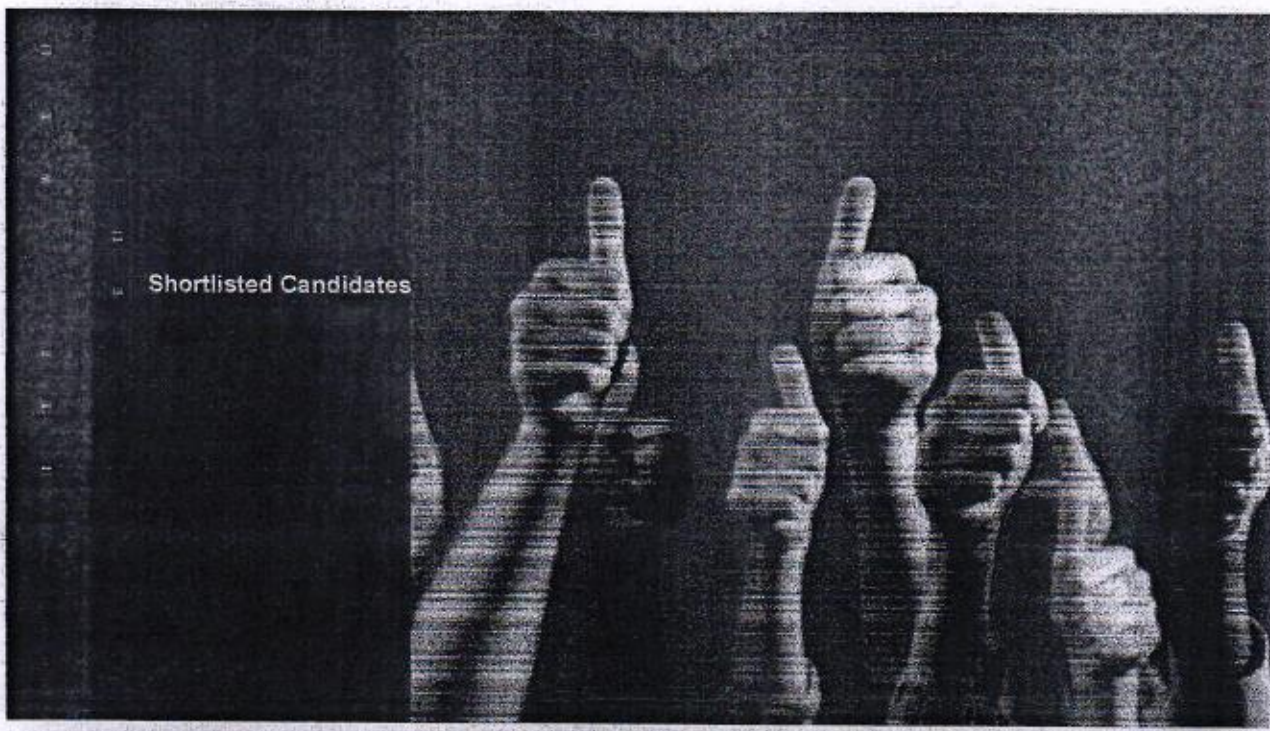

Formulation and Evaluation of Chitosan Based Superporous Hydrogel of Simvastatin

P A Pokharana^{1*}, S Z Chemate¹, D A Pavale¹

Abstract: The main aim of present research work was to formulate and evaluate chitosan based superporous hydrogel of simvastatin and to provide controlled release dosage form of by formulating gastric retention device. Simvastatin was chosen as good candidate for such system due to its narrow absorption window, low bioavailability and short half-life. SPHs were prepared by using chitosan and PVA (polymers), glyoxal (crosslinker), sodium bicarbonate (foaming agent), Span 80 (foam stabilizer). GAA and water were used to prepare chitosan and PVA solutions respectively. Direct addition method is used for drug loading. Suitable drug loading method was determined on the basis of drug content and *in-vitro* dissolution study. Optimized SPHs were evaluated for physical and mechanical properties like swelling ratio, gelation kinetics, density, viscosity, porosity, degradation kinetics, FT-IR spectroscopy, DSC. Direct addition method showed % drug release 95.31% with complete swelling of SPH. Results for optimized batch evaluation were found to be: The swelling ratio 3.70; after 90 min. at pH 1.2, gelation time; 29 sec., density; 0.41 ± 0.003 g/cm³, viscosity; 210.1 ± 4.75 cP, porosity; 89.77 ± 4.83 , degradation study; WRT of 0.037 after 42 hr. Stability studies were carried out for 3 month as per ICH guidelines. There was no significant change in % drug release and other evaluation parameters. From above studies it can be concluded that the SPH of Simvastatin can be successfully formulated and evaluated.

INTRODUCTION

The hydrogels since their discovery by Wichterle and Lim in 1960 of poly (2-hydroxyethyl methacrylate), have been of great interest to biomedical scientists.^[1, 2] Superporous hydrogels were recently developed for their potential applications in controlled drug delivery, especially for developing oral gastric retention devices. A superporous hydrogel is a three-dimensional network of a hydrophilic polymer that absorbs a large amount of water in a very short period of time due to the presence of interconnected microscopic pores.

Gastric retention of superporous hydrogels is based on the fast swelling of dried hydrogels to a size larger than the pyloric sphincter. When applied as drug carriers, these highly swollen hydrogels remain in stomach for a long time, releasing almost all drugs loaded, as their volumes are too big to transport through the pylorus. Chitosan is a natural polysaccharide, is a biocompatible, biodegradable and nontoxic material. Because of abundant amine groups within chitosan polymer chain, it dissolves in acidic solution and forms a gel with dialdehydes such as glutaraldehyde and glyoxal. Thus, in the low pH solution, chitosan hydrogels swell due to the presence of the positive charges in the network. Poly (vinyl alcohol) is a well known hydrophilic, biocompatible and commercially available polymer. The objective of the study was to prepare and evaluate chitosan/PVA Superporous hydrogel. In this study, the interpenetrating polymer network of chitosan/PVA Superporous hydrogel was prepared using a gas blowing technique. It was prepared using glyoxal as a crosslinking agent.^[3, 4]

Simvastatin is an anti hyperlipidaemic. HMG-COA reductase inhibitor is the drug of choice in the treatment of hypercholesterolemia and dyslipidemia. Simvastatin

undergoes extensive first pass metabolism by oral route and thus exhibits only 5% oral bioavailability. Simvastatin is a twice as potent as lovastatin, also more efficacious. It is lipophilic and given in the lactone precursor form. Therefore, Superporous hydrogel drug delivery system might be advantageous for Simvastatin.^[5, 6]

MATERIALS AND METHODS

Chitosan was procured from Ozone International, Mumbai, Glyoxal (40 % aqueous solution), Span 80 and ethanol were procured from LOBA Chemie Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai. Sodium bicarbonate and polyvinyl alcohol were procured from SD Fine-CHEM Ltd, Mumbai. Simvastatin was obtained as a gift sample from Wockhardt Pharma Ltd, L-1, Chikhalthana, Aurangabad.

Preformulation Studies

1. Differential scanning calorimetry

Thermogram of Simvastatin was recorded on a Perkinimal 4000 Thermal Analyzer with pyris software by using Nitrogen purging (20 ml/min) with Aluminum pan at 30-300°C.

2. FT-IR Spectroscopy

The Fourier Transform Infrared (FTIR) spectral measurements were recorded at ambient temperature using IR spectrophotometer. The spectrum of pure drug (Simvastatin) was analyzed for the purity of the drug.

3. Compatibility Study

It is carried out by using DSC and IR spectroscopy. Mixture of drug and polymer (Simvastatin, Chitosan and PVA) was prepared in 1:1:1 ratio and analyzed by DSC and IR spectrophotometry.

Determination of Analytical Wavelength

Accurately weighed 10 mg of Simvastatin was dissolved in 10 ml of 0.1N HCl and stock solution of concentration 100 µg/ml was prepared. From this stock solution, solution of 20 µg/ml concentration was prepared and scanned over the

A Study on Effect of Binders on Drug Release from Lornoxicam Tablet Formulation

S Z Chemate¹, Shete Pritee S^{1*}, Avhad Shubhangi L¹

Abstract: Lornoxicam tablets were prepared by conventional wet granulation method using various binding agents. Lornoxicam, a widely prescribed non steroidal anti-inflammatory drug with analgesic properties, belonging to the oxamic class. The objective of the present work was to study the effect of various binding agents on qualities and dissolution rate of lornoxicam tablets. Compressed tablets each containing 8 mg of lornoxicam were prepared using various binders namely acacia, tragacanth, gelatin, xanthan gum, HPMC K4M, PVP K30, PVA and MCC. The effects of binding agents on the physical characteristics of lornoxicam granules were studied. The granules were evaluated for angle of repose, bulk density, compressibility index and the tablets were evaluated for content of active ingredient, hardness, friability, disintegration time, dissolution rate. The binder used has significant influence on the tablet and rate of lornoxicam from the tablets.

INTRODUCTION

Conventional tablets are our everyday tablet, a powder that's pressed together into a solid mass. The tablet is the most widely used dosage form because of its convenience in terms of self administration, accurate dosage, compactness, ease in manufacturing, pain avoidance and most important patient compliance. In wet granulation process the surface polarity of both powder and binders are important factors in determining the strength of granules. Binders and powder with similar surface polarities produce strong granules and degree of polymerization increases the strength of granules.

Lornoxicam, a congener of tenoxicam, is a new NSAID belonging to the oxamic class. It is a strong analgesic and anti-inflammatory NSAID as compared to other NSAIDs. Its analgesic activity is comparable to that of opioids. It is a potent analgesic with excellent anti-inflammatory properties. Clinically, nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs are the most frequently prescribed by physicians for inflammatory disorders. NSAIDs exert their effect through inhibition of cyclooxygenase-II, the main form of isozyme associated with inflammation. But the simultaneous inhibition of cyclooxygenase-I. [3, 8, 9]

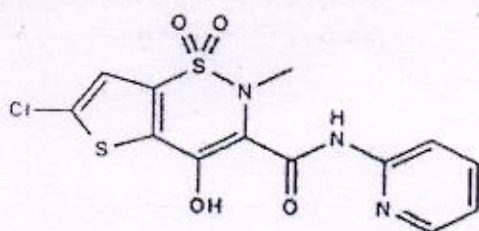


Figure 1: Chemical structure of lornoxicam

The objective of this study was to evaluate the various physical characteristics of granules and the effect of eight binding agents, on the tablet qualities and dissolution rate was studied to optimize the formulation of lornoxicam tablets. In the present study, we have investigated the

influence of some binders on the dissolution studies of Lornoxicam tablets.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

Lornoxicam was obtained as a gift sample from Abbott healthcare pvt.ltd. sai road, batauli khurd, Baddi. Dist-solan, Himachal Pradesh, India. Acacia, Tragacanth, Gelatin, Xanthan gum, Microcrystalline cellulose obtained from Ozone International, Mumbai. HPMC K4M, sodium starch glycolate obtained from Ranbaxy Fine Chem. Ltd., Delhi. PVP K30, PVA, Talc, procured from S.D. Fine Chemicals Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai. Sucrose, Starch, Mag. stearate obtained from LOBA Chemiv Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai.

Preparation of Lornoxicam Tablets [1, 2]

Compressed tablets each containing 8 mg of lornoxicam were prepared by wet granulation method using various binders as per the formulae given.

Wet granulation method was used to prepare tablets. Formulation with different binders was compressed into tablets. The required quantities of Lornoxicam, Sucrose and Starch (Diluent), Sod. Starchglycolate (Disintegrant) were weighed accurately using analytical balance and were mixed well using laboratory conditions. The aqueous binder solution was added and mixed thoroughly to form dough mass. The mass was passed through mesh No.12 to obtain wet granules. The wet granules were dried in a hot air oven at 40°C temperatures. Then the dried granules were passed through mesh No.16 to break the aggregates. Talc (0.72 gm) and Mag. Stearate (0.36 gm) were passed through mesh No.100 onto dry granules and blended in a polyethylene bag. The tablet granules were then compressed using single punch in a multistation compression machine, which is equipped with 8 mm concave edge punches.

Evaluation of Tablet Formulations

1. Pre-compression Parameters

a. Bulk Density

Apparent bulk density (pb) was determined by placing pre-sieved drug excipients blend into a graduated cylinder and measuring the volume (v_b) and weight (M) "as it is".

$$\text{Bulk density} = \text{Weight of powder} / \text{Bulk volume}$$



Phage Therapy: Emergence of a Novel Therapy to Control Bacterial Pathogens

Abstract: Increased nuisance of multidrug resistant bacteria is a serious health problem these days. Persistent use of broad spectrum antibiotics is ceasing the efficacy of antibiotics. Phage induced bacterial lysis represents the bactericidal effect-phage therapy. Safe and effective use of bacterial viruses is showing good potential against multidrug resistant bacteria. Phage therapy has some disadvantages but it seems to be a good option for this problem. Phage resistance can also be overcome using phage cocktails-polyphage therapy. Phage structure, its ability to destruct the bacterial cell, hollins and endolysins activity, pros and cons of the therapy are the important aspects to be considered during phage treatment. Though phage therapy is better alternate for multidrug resistance, rigorous research work and extensive regulatory control is needed.

INTRODUCTION

To overcome the heralds of multidrug resistant bacteria (like vancomycin as well as carbamazepine has gained resistance to MRSA bacteria leading to further drug resistance in such organisms), rigorous research activities are ongoing to develop alternate methods. Bacteriophages are the viruses that infect bacteria. They have many potential applications in biotechnology that are currently being explored such as being used as delivery vehicles for vaccines and gene therapy, detecting bacterial pathogens and screening libraries of peptides or antibodies. Phage therapy takes advantage of this particular group of viruses in a relatively simple way; it aims to treat bacterial infections through the application of such phages. Though for some time people did not consider this use of bacteriophages feasible, since the emergence of many antibiotic-resistant pathogens, the field is again on the rise. Recent WHO figures suggest that 14,000 people die in the US alone every year due to multidrug-resistant bacteria acquired in hospitals. Luckily, bacteriophages are found in all bacteria so there is at least a theoretical possibility that therapies can be developed for all species of bacteria. [1] As humans are unlikely to be able to come up with novel antibiotics forever and bacteria will probably continue to evolve resistances, so it is important that new ways of combating such infection should be discovered. Phages are the most diverse, semiautonomous, genetic agents on earth with total phage number ranging to in excess of 10^{30} virions. [2] They are specialized deliverers of bactericidal agents to the cytoplasm of bacteria they target. [3]

Bacterial viruses (bacteriophages) occupy all the habitats of the world where bacteria thrive. It has been estimated that for each bacterial cell there are ten bacteriophage particles. Some phages are highly specific while others are extremely broad in their host range. Bacteriophage taxonomy is based on their shape and size as well as on their nucleic acid. Most bacteriophages have DNA; however, some have DNA or RNA.

Phage therapy is the therapeutic use of bacteriophages to treat pathogenic bacterial infections. [4] Bacteriophages were discovered independently by Twort (1915) at Browns Veterinary Hospital in London and by d'Herelle (1917) at the Institute Pasteur in Paris. Phages exclusively attack and lyse a bacteria (often of a particular species or strain), which prompted d'Herelle to develop the term "bacteriophage," meaning "bacteria-eater". [5,6] Shortly after the discovery of phages, d'Herelle proposed their use in combating infection and used phages to treat patients with dysentery, bubonic plague and cholera with some success. Although there were reports of successful phage treatment, not all phage therapy testing was effective. These variable results were most likely due to a lack of knowledge in the area of phage biology, a lack of understanding regarding phage specificity, the use of phage to treat conditions not caused by a bacterial infection, improper phage preparation leading to phage inactivation and an inability to produce high volumes of purified phage. 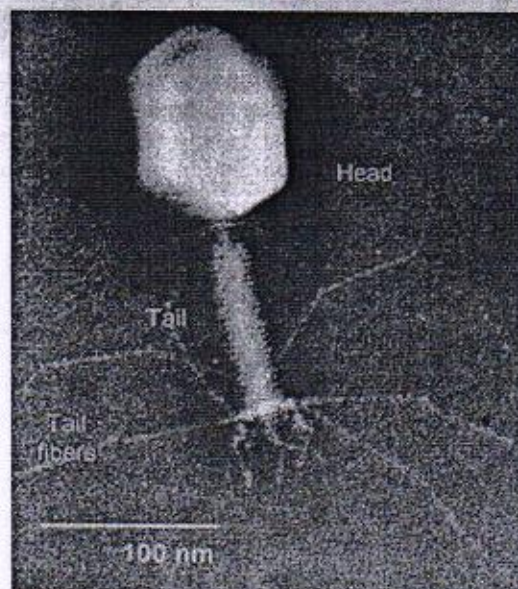


Figure 1: Electron micrograph of a bacteriophage

BACTERIOPHAGE STRUCTURE AND RECEPTORS

Bacteriophages or simply phages are viruses with an ability to infect and, in many cases, kill bacterial cells. As with most viruses, these infections begin with virion binding to specific cell-surface receptors, which is then followed by

ANALYTICAL METHOD DEVELOPMENT FOR ESTIMATION OF S (-) AMLODIPINE BESYLATE & OLMESARTAN MEDOXOMIL BY UV SPECTROSCOPY

ABSTRACT

For simultaneous estimation of S (-) amlodipine besylate & olmesartan medoxomil, the simple, accurate, precise, reproducible and economic UV spectroscopic methods have been developed. The method A- Area Under curve method, method B- Absorption ratio method and method C- Dual wavelength method were developed by using JASCO double beam UV Spectrophotometer (model-V630). Simultaneous estimation of S(-) amlodipine Besylate and olmesartan medoxomil was carried out at wavelength 238 nm and 257 nm respectively. Both the drugs were showing linearity at 238 nm and 257 nm and obey Beer's law in the concentration range of 5-20µg/ml with good correlation coefficient. In Area under curve method, wavelength selected for S (-) amlodipine besylate was from 227 to 249 nm and for olmesartan medoxomil was from 244 to 269 nm. It gives peak area of 1.9585 for S (-) amlodipine besylate and 2.1252 for Olmesartan medoxomil. Absorption ratio method involves formation of isoabsorptive point at 237 nm.

INTRODUCTION

Hypertension is a progressive cardiovascular syndrome arising from complex and interrelated etiologies. Hypertension is the state in which systolic blood pressure (SBP) of 140 mm Hg or greater or a diastolic blood pressure (DBP) of 90 mm Hg or greater. Multiple mechanisms are involved in the pathogenesis of hypertension. Therefore it is multifactorial condition and combination therapy makes it more effective than monotherapy¹. Combination of Calcium Channel Blockers and Angiotensin Receptor Blockers are emerging as convenient and rational options for antihypertensive treatment. S (-) amlodipine besylate, a calcium channel blocker (CCB) and olmesartan medoxomil, an Angiotensin

receptor Blocker (ARB) are the drugs used therein. S (-) amlodipine besylate selectively inhibits calcium influx across cell membranes in cardiac and vascular smooth muscle, with a greater effect on vascular smooth muscle. Olmesartan blocks the vasoconstrictor effects of Angiotensin II by selectively blocking the binding of Angiotensin II to the AT1 receptor in vascular smooth muscle.

S (-) amlodipine Besylate is 3-ethyl-5-methyl(±)-2-[(2-aminoethoxy)methyl]-4-(2-chlorophenyl)-1,4-dihydro-6-methyl-3,5-pyridinedicarboxylate, mono benzene sulpho nate with empirical formula $C_{20}H_{25}ClN_2O_5 \cdot C_6H_6O_3S$. It is the dihydropyridine agent of antihypertensive class. Olmesartan medoxomil is a prodrug, hydrolysed to olmesartan during absorption from GIT. Chemically it is 2,3-dihydroxy-2-butenyl 4 (1-hydroxy-1-methylethyl) 2-propyl-1-[p-(o-1H-tetrazol-5-yl-phenyl) benzyl] imidazole

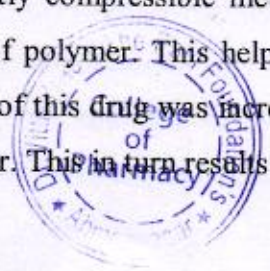

The present study is to formulate an anti-diabetic tablet containing permeation enhancer which enhances gastrointestinal absorption of poorly absorbable anti-diabetic drug. Metformin hydrochloride (HCl) is a BCS class III drug which has high solubility and poor intestinal absorption characteristic. The gastrointestinal absorption of metformin hydrochloride was enhanced using permeation enhancer like cyclodextrin. The permeation of drug was measured by everted sac technique using chicken intestine. The drug was absorbed through chicken intestine mainly by passive diffusion mechanism. The absorbed drug was determined by using U.V Visible Spectrophotometer at 234nm. After analyzing the results it was found that cyclodextrin enhance the absorption of metformin hydrochloride from chicken intestine. This cyclodextrin was used to reduce dose of

metformin hydrochloride in tablet dosage form. For optimizing the dose of metformin hydrochloride, different batches of different permeation enhancer were used and tablets were prepared by direct compression method with different concentration of permeation enhancer and metformin hydrochloride. Metformin hydrochloride exhibits poor compressibility during compaction, often resulting in weak and unacceptable tablets with a high tendency to cap. The purpose was to develop directly compressible metformin hydrochloride by the spray-drying technique in the presence of polymer. This help in increase in the flow property of metformin HCL. The permeability of this drug was increased by the addition of cyclodextrin which acts as a permeation enhancer. This in turn results in better absorption enhancement.
